

Title of the document

All paragraphs have a spacing on bottom by default, making it easier for the readers to distinguish between huge blocks of text. Also, the default line-spacing is set to 150%. The text is rendered as dark anthracite instead of black.

An alternative body text is also available using the regular font-weight. This can be used for documents where the light variant is undesired.

Side margins were shrunk which makes the documents easier to accommodate multi column views.

Example paragraphs

This example paragraph text has a footnote associated¹, please note the distance between footnotes and the footer text.

The weight between headers and content is well distributed.

Fixed width text for coders

This style also features a fixed-width style paragraph for code examples. The fixed width font used is Menlo, a nice monospaced font with bold and italic variants.

Tables have been redesigned as well. By default only line separators are visible after the header and before totals, also headers use bold condensed font instead of a background. Headers are aligned to the left rather than centered. They are made to be centered, however this can not be set as default in Pages.

A bullet list is nicely spaced and indented:

Headers - level 1

Lighter than text font and different font variant.

Smaller text and even lighter font color.
